Interview each enrolled participant (after taking consent) for symptom screening and history taking 5. Enter all information during interview in the android application on tablet. 6. Ensure that sputum is collected from each eligible based on symptom screening. 7. Advise participants about the next place to proceed, accompany the participant if needed. 8. Coordinate with local health staff (e.g. FHW) and MO / Survey Team Leader to ensure that all pregnant women are excluded from the study. Arrange for pregnancy test if required. 9. Ensure that chest X-Ray has been taken for all eligible participants. 10. Motivate the local staff, volunteers, to promote more participation in Survey. 11.
